



Defensive Strategy Workshop

During the Easter Holidays, spurred by the success of our winning bids with The Veterans Foundation and Saint Safe, our team energetically embarked on the implementation of our Workshop. Defensive Strategy purposefully The initiative was designed to combat violent crime and disorder. Our strategy involved scheduling the course during school holiday periods, strategically targeting a reduction in antisocial behavior. By conducting the sessions during this time, participants could benefit from a secure and conducive learning atmosphere. Geared towards both 15-year-olds and adults, the program aimed to empower teenagers to communicate and interact confidently with adults, fostering a sense of self-assurance and engagement.

The course was meticulously crafted using a three-tier approach, ensuring participants received comprehensive education on various facets of personal safety and community well-being. Firstly, participants delved into the profound impact of violent crime, gaining insights into its consequences on individuals and society as a whole. Secondly, emphasis was placed on conflict resolution techniques, equipping attendees with valuable skills to defuse potentially volatile situations peacefully. Additionally, self-defence training was integrated into the curriculum, empowering participants with practical methods to protect themselves if faced with danger. Lastly, the program included an immersive accredited first aid course, enabling participants to respond effectively to medical emergencies and potentially save lives. This multifaceted approach aimed to provide participants with a holistic understanding of personal safety while arming them with practical tools for both prevention and response.



Armed Forces Compensation Scheme Military Injury

Serving in the Armed Forces is a dangerous job. There are risks involved and it's inevitable that people will be injured. However, the Ministry of Defence (MoD) has a responsibility to minimise those risks where possible.

Armed Forces Compensation Scheme (AFCS)

The AFCS is a no-fault scheme set up by the Government to compensate military personnel who have suffered injury, illness or death during the course of service or have a pre-existing condition that's been made worse by service. It came into force on 6 April 2005 and applies to injuries sustained on or after that date.

Who and what does it cover?

The scheme makes no distinction between serving, veteran and reserve personnel. It also makes no distinction between injuries sustained on operations, training exercises, service approved sports or whilst exercising to maintain military fitness. This is because it's accepted that a member of the Armed Forces has no choice or control over where they're deployed or the activities in which they are required to engage in.

The scheme pays a lump sum on a tariff based system, which is determined by the severity of the injury. The minimum award that can be received is £1,236, and the maximum is £650,000 for injures of the utmost severity. The AFCS also provide a regular tax-free Guaranteed Income Payment (GIP), payable for life, alongside higher level tariff awards for those who suffer significant loss of earning capacity.

In certain circumstances there may be a supplementary award payable where an injury doesn't necessarily affect employment prospects but may affect self-esteem and confidence, for example, where an injury has caused damage to your reproductive organs.

How do I make a claim?

A claim is made by filling in the application form and sending to Veterans UK, who administer the scheme. It's necessary to give Veterans UK evidence that the injury was caused by, or made worse by service. Once that's accepted, they'll require medical evidence showing the nature and severity of the injury itself; this will determine which tariff band they apply.

An award can either be a final award if the prognosis is clear or it can be an interim award if, for example, recovery is still taking place and it's not possible to make a final decision, which would provide some compensation in the meantime. We're able to offer advice and guidance with your application.

Is there a time limit?

Claims must be made within seven years from the date the injury is sustained, made worse by service, or the date upon which help was first sought in the case of post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) or mental health issues.

How we can help

The scheme is meant to be fair, transparent and accessible. However AFCS law is a specialised area and although Veterans UK advises that applicants can navigate the system alone and achieve the correct outcome, the reality in some cases can be quite different.

Unfortunately, the AFCS doesn't require independent medical evidence to be obtained. This means military personnel will often be awarded amounts that are unfair, because the complete medical position hasn't been taken into account.

Having an AFCS award doesn't prevent an individual from making a claim for damages through the civil courts if they believe their injury was due to negligence. However, compensation can't be paid twice for the same injury so if there's been an AFCS award then it'll be taken into account when any damages are paid from a civil courts claim.




